
Other Matters

Returning Officer actions required (Section 193): Yes

Details:

- As there is no rule pertaining to the withdrawal of the Nomination, the Returning Officer applied subparagraph 193(1) (b)(ii) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisation) Act 2009 to fix a closing time for the withdrawal of the nomination and the withdrawal period was aligned with the close of the nomination period.
- Branch rule 10.4 provides that the election of members of the Branch Executive shall be in accordance with Federal Rule 17, with the necessary changes. Federal rules 17(p) and 17(r) states that the ballot to be closed on the 22nd day after the opening of the ballot. Due to current delivery times taken by the Australia Post, the ballot period was not sufficient. The Returning Officer applied subparagraph 193(1) (b)(ii) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisation) Act 2009 to extend the period and allowed 28 days instead of 22 days.
