## Evidence collection period

**Monday 19<sup>th</sup> April 2021 to Friday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2022.**

**Please note changes to date for submission of portfolios by Friday 9<sup>th</sup> Sept 2022.**

It is important to start this process as early as possible after the **19<sup>th</sup> April 2021**.

## Eligibility:
