Guest Speaker: Emilie Miller **Bathurst's own golden girl**

Emilie is 23 years old and lives in Bathurst. At 12 years old she was an incredibly active young girl, competing at a national level for swimming. Emilie was ranked in the top 10 in Australia for her age group in 11 events, when she sustained a spinal injury during a diving accident which left her a quadriplegic.

Following her accident she returned to competitive swimming again at a national level, before swapping to the sport of para-cycling at the age of 16.



Emilie is now a member of the Australian Para-cycling Team, competing at World Championship level. She represented Australia in 2015, 2017 and 2018. Most recently, in 2018 she competed at the World Championships in Italy, where she won two World Championship gold medals in both the Time Trial and Road Race events. She was also awarded Cycling Australia's Female Para-cycling Athlete of the Year for 2018.

In her life outside of cycling, Emilie is a Primary School Teacher and a Swimming Coach. She completed a Bachelor of Education (Primary) and a Postgraduate Degree in Business (Sports Management).
