- show awareness of legal and policy frameworks that protect students and translate these to an educational context
- understand the impacts of homophobia and transphobia, including the role of teacher and staff as a supportive or risk factor in the lives of young SSAIGD people.
- start development of an Action Plan that identifies strategies to increase supportiveness and inclusivity of the school/centre to improve outcomes for SSAIGD students, staff and community members.
