
Same qualifications and roles, *lower pay*

Community Preschools Annual Pay Comparison Chart



Note: These comparisons are an approximation of the equivalent pay scales between services, as pay scales for primary teachers don't align exactly with preschool and long day care pay scales. The pay scales shown here for primary teachers represent the lowest pay a teacher with the equivalent qualification and experience (e.g. a teacher who has just achieved a proficient accreditation) can earn.
