Vote Yes for your EA

Since our last [NewsExtra update](#), the IEU has reached agreement with Model A schools on the terms of the new MEAs, delivering improved pay and conditions for teachers and support staff.

The proposed MEAs are now ready to move towards a vote. The union urges members to vote YES.

What we have won through bargaining

IEU Wins	
Annual increases for salaries and allowances: February 2026: 3.75% (backpaid to February 2026 on approval of the new MEAs) February 2027: 3.5% February 2028: 3.25%	✓
Introduction of 12 weeks of paid non-initial primary carer's leave (parental leave)	✓
Superannuation payable on paid parental leave entitlements	✓
Introduction of two days of paid cultural and ceremonial leave	✓

Wins for Teachers

IEU Wins	
A unique but competitive Model A classification structure offering six steps, including two additional steps in Band 2, while retaining the Band 3 classification for teachers with ISTAA accreditation and who have over 7 years' experience, or who are deemed to be Band 3	✓
Introduction of a workload transparency clause requiring the employer to advise teachers of their workload expectations on appointment and from time to time	✓
Retention of 14 weeks of paid parental leave <i>exclusive</i> of non-term time for teachers	✓
Introduction of a new Highly Accomplished or Lead Teacher allowance to recognise and reward teachers with a higher level of professional accreditation	✓
Progression to Band 3 to occur upon satisfying the eligibility criteria instead of waiting until the following February	✓

Broadening coverage to include counsellors and psychologists	✓
Aligning the evidence required for taking paid personal/carers leave with the requirements for teachers, making it less onerous	✓
